- slate, porphyry

- terracotta, gres, clinker
- granite, marble

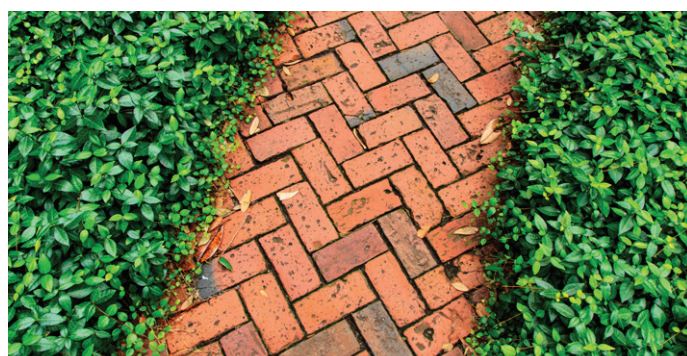

Characteristics

The impregnate is an aqueous solution of a fluoropolymer that provides a durable, transparent, hydrophilic, and hydrophobic protective barrier on porous surfaces. The impregnate protects the surface against the absorption of water, grease, and dirt while allowing for easy cleaning. It effectively protects against coffee, juice, wine, ketchup stains, and all kinds of fat, etc. It reduces the absorbency of the surface without changing its color. It does not turn yellow and does not form a film. It does not affect breathing through the pores of the surface. It is suitable for indoor and outdoor applications.

Application:

Before impregnation, the surface should be thoroughly cleaned and degreased. The substrate should be dry, free from grease and dust. The product should be applied with a brush, roller, sponge or by spraying until the impregnation is completely absorbed. The excess of unabsorbed preparation should be removed with a sponge or wiper. Apply the second layer using the "wet on wet" method. Leave to dry for a minimum of 4 hours. Use at temperatures between +5°C and +30°C. After finishing work, wash the tools in water with detergent.



Colouring: colourless.

Efficiency:

Consumption depends on the degree of absorption, the type of impregnated substrate and the method of application.

Packaging:

Metal can 350 ml and 800 ml.

Transport and storage:

Store and transport in the tight, original packaging, at a temperature between +5°C and +40°C.

Shelf life: 36 months.

Comments:
