

KEIM Soliprim Primer for interior use



1. Product description

KEIM Soliprim is a special silicate primer for interior use based on a binder combination of hydrosol and silica sol.

2. Field of application

KEIM Soliprim may be used

- to equalise differing levels of absorbency of mineral and organic substrates, sound existing coatings or mixed substrates.
- to fix and consolidate chalking or sanding substrates.
- to optimise surface homogeneity of subsequent coats of paint, in particular under difficult light conditions.

3. Product properties

- Binder basis: hydrosol and silica sol
- Equalising
- Highly effective for substrate consolidation
- Promotes adhesion
- Penetrates deep into the material
- Breathable, microporous
- Slight silicifying action
- No solvents added
- Low odour

- Organic content: < 5%

Colour shade

Slightly milky

4. Application instructions

Substrate preparation

The substrate must be dry, clean and free of grease.

Application

Apply KEIM Soliprim preferably undiluted with a brush. Roller or spray application are also possible. Avoid shiners. Highly absorbent substrates may need two coats applied wet-on-wet.

Note

KEIM Soliprim cannot be used as a diluent.

Application conditions

Air and substrate temperature > 5°C

Drying time

A drying time of at least 6 hours must be left between primer and subsequent coat.

Consumption

0.1–0.2 l/m² per coat depending on the absorbency of the substrate. Determine precise consumption by trial application on object.

Cleaning of tools

Clean with water immediately after use.

5. Packaging

5 and 20 l containers

6. Storage

Shelf life is approx. 12 months in a sealed container under cool, but frost-free conditions. Protect from heat and direct sunlight.

7. Disposal

EC Waste Code No. 08 01 12

Any residues must be emptied out of containers before recycling.



8. Safety instructions

KEIM Soliprim is slightly alkaline.

Provide appropriate protection for surfaces which are not to be treated (e.g. glass, ceramics, wood etc.).

Any splashes on surrounding surfaces or traffic areas must be rinsed off immediately with plenty of water.

Protect the eyes and skin from splashes. Keep out of reach of children.
